

Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians

- I will do my best to be a GOODSPORT at all times. I will not condone, permit, defend, or engage in actions, on or off the ice, which are not consistent with good sportsmanship.
- I will encourage my child to do his or her best, have fun and demonstrate good sportsmanship. I will teach my child how to win and lose gracefully. I will lead by example.
- I will assist my child to understand and respect the rules of the game. I will encourage my child to remember that he or she is part of a team and to work for the good of the team.
- I will respect the rights and feelings of officials, coaches, trainers, players, volunteers and administrators. I will work to support, not undermine, their efforts.
- I will not permit my actions to embarrass the hockey association: coaches, board members or other volunteers, players, referees including my own child.
- I will set an example by supporting & respecting my child's coach. When problems or issues arise I will follow the proper protocol as established by the board in dealing with these issues like respecting the 24 hour cool down rule & seek the services of the parent rep to initiate a speedy resolution. Public comments are not appropriate.
- I will accept any suspensions handed out by the referee & all sanctions placed by the coach &/or the executive board for the inappropriate behavior of my child or myself.

Please note: Sanctions will be enacted for all non-compliances with the above code. Each violation will be dealt with on an individual basis with an appropriate sanction issued.
